Evaluating the use of the Food Follower app (Part of the Monitoring adherence to allergy prevention recommendations (MAAPR) study)

You are invited to participate in the research project described below.

What is the project about?

The research project will investigate what common allergy causing foods are being fed to babies and how often they are being offered.

Who is undertaking the project?

This project is being conducted by Dr Sandra Vale (chief investigator), Dr Merryn Netting, A/Prof Kevin Murray and Milo Radunski at The University of Western Australia.

What will I be asked to do?

If you decide to participate in this study, you will be allowing us to access de-identified information that you enter into the Nip allergies in the Bub Food Follower app. This means that we would only use information that cannot identify you or your baby in any way.

Are there any risks associated with participating in this project?

There is no foreseeable risk in you participating in this research project.

What are the benefits of the research project?

By participating in this study, you will help us to identify resources and information to help prevent babies from developing food allergies.

What if I change my mind?

Participation in this study is completely voluntary. Participants are free to withdraw from the study at any time and can do so without explanation. If you withdraw from the study, you will have the option to remove your data from study. However, any data that has already been analysed will not be able to be removed.

How will you keep my information private and confidential?

All information will be stored securely, password protected on UWA servers and only the researchers will have access to this information during the project.

Once the study is completed, the data collected from you will be stored securely and destroyed 7 years after publication, as per university policy for research data management (WA University Sector Disposal Authority guidelines). The data may be used in future research. The results of the study will be published as a journal article.

Will I be able to find out the results of the project?

Once we have analysed the information we will provide a summary of our findings on the National Allergy Council website (www.nationalallergycouncil.org.au). This will be available in September 2028.
